- If you select the "all year" option and it is granted, you will not be able to switch out of the site without extenuating circumstances and permission of the Vice Dean for Educational and Academic Affairs.
- Rotation order may only be changed *within the site* following the final lottery run if availability/trade exists.
- All year students must follow the instructions from Family Medicine in order to obtain your All Year site placement. Family Medicine will place all year students prior to rotating students. Student must prioritize the assigned all year site as #1 for your Family Medicine Site.
- If you are required to make schedule changes at a later date for any reason, the "all-year" option may not be able to be maintained.
- All year agreement is for 2019-2020 academic year, May-May.
- If you feel you have an extenuating circumstance for placement, you must also complete a Special Needs Request form (i.e., accommodation from the Drexel Office of Disability Resources or parental responsibilities)
- If there are more students than slots available, a lottery will be held.
- Housing is the responsibility of the student. No housing is available through the hospital, even at cost.
- Completion of this form is not a guarantee of placement.
- The College reserves the right to make schedule changes based on academic performance.
- **Student must meet and continue to meet eligibility as indicated in the Drexel University College of Medicine Student Handbook.**

You will be notified no later than Thursday, January 17th, if your request will be accommodated. Further instructions will be provided at that time. **If your request cannot be accommodated, you will need to enter your lottery choices on-line in accordance with the posted lottery deadline.** For Family Medicine, all students must submit a Family Medicine lottery request; consistent with your all year request as indicated above even if you receive an all year request.

If you are awarded an All Year slot, you will be asked to rank a reduced selection of specified grid options (order of rotations). Students will be provided a grid via lottery if no grid matches a selected option. **Rotations are scheduled to accommodate the majority of students without interruption in rotations.** When necessary, order of rotations is at the discretion of the Division of Clinical Education in order to fit the maximum number of students.
